

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUTTLE, GRADY COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION AS TO THE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED PROPERTY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUTTLE, GRADY COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That the zoning classification and zoning regulations and ordinance of the City of Tuttle, Grady County, State of Oklahoma, be changed from C-1 to C-5 for Bill Berry, located at 406 E Main Street, Tuttle, OK. Legal description is as follows:

A tract of land located in Lot Three (3), being the fractional Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of Section Two (2) in Township Nine (9) North, Range Six (6) West of the Indian Meridian, described by metes and bounds as follows:
Beginning at a point 150 feet West of the Northeast Corner (NE/C) of the West Eight (8) acres of the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of the Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW/4), being a point 150 feet West of the Northeast corner (NE/C) of the West Eight (8) acres of the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of said Lot Three (3), Section Two (2), Township Nine (9) North, Range Six (6) West; thence running West 80 feet, thence South 230 feet, thence East 80 feet, thence North 230 feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, and safety of the Citizens of Tuttle, Oklahoma that an emergency be declared.

WHEREFORE, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage, approval and publication.
