

CITY OF TUTTLE ORDINANCE NO. 2011-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUTTLE, GRADY COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF TUTTLE, AMENDING THE SIGN REGULATIONS TO INCLUDE AWARENESS SIGNS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUTTLE, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1: Section 5-149, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Tuttle is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 5-149. Signs.

1. Only signs issued by the City shall be permitted (including those garage sales located outside of the City of Tuttle). These signs may be installed 48 hours prior to sale date. Signs shall be removed within 48 hours after expiration of permit.
2. The location of garage sale signs shall be regulated by the City's Signage Regulations, as adopted and amended by the City Council.
3. A fine of \$10 per sign shall be assessed for each day a sign does not conform to these regulations.
4. Real estate-type signs of a professional nature meeting all sign criteria pursuant to local sign ordinances indicating the location of a garage sale are allowed with specific approval by the City. In addition to a garage sale permit each real estate-type sign will require a permit sticker be issued for a fee set by the council, by motion or resolution.
